A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND REAL ESTATE TAX PAYMENT  
DEADLINES DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, Governor Tom Wolf declared a disaster emergency on March 6, 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, many businesses were forced to close which has led to a staggering loss of jobs; and

WHEREAS, the economic downturn has created an economic hardship for many taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, Governor Tom Wolf signed Act 15 on April 20, 2020 that enables local governments to extend real estate tax deadlines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisors of the Township of Cook, County of Westmoreland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the discount period discounting the 2020 municipal real estate taxes by 2%, shall be extended to August 31, 2020.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all penalties for 2020 municipal real estate taxes shall be waived if said taxes are paid in full by December 31, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all unpaid 2020 municipal real estate taxes after December 31, 2020 shall be subject to the normal delinquent penalties and fees pursuant to the Real Estate Tax Sale Law, the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, the Municipal Claim & Tax Lien Law, and any other state statute or ordinance of the Township of Cook.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Cook Township real estate tax collector no later than May 20, 2020.
